City Hosts Visioning Workshop for Clifton-Le Doux Corridor Mobility Study

Residents Invited to Provide Input on Transportation Safety and Access

Beverly Hills, CA – The City of Beverly Hills has kicked off a Corridor Mobility Study for Clifton Way and Le Doux Road. This project will explore the feasibility of a range of traffic calming and active mobility enhancement options aimed at making residential streets more livable and improving pedestrian and bicycle connections to the future Metro D (Purple) Line Stations.

The first step in the project is to meet with stakeholders to identify a vision for the corridor and understand any issues they hope to address with a potential design. Residents are invited to participate in a Community Visioning Workshop to share their ideas for the Clifton-Le Doux corridor:

WHEN: Saturday, October 15, 2022 from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM

WHERE: La Cienega Park Community Center
