# Marketing Subcommittee

• Marketing Subcommittee Chair Noelle Freeman gave updates on recent media successes, including but not limited to, two placements about Next Night 2019 in the Beverly Hills Courier, a Google Analytics score of 89 for Next Night 2019, which was double the score from Next Night 2018, a 12% organic growth increase over the last six months, an email opening engagement rate of 73%. Noelle also shared that the welcome video series for new members is almost complete and that the Committee has a growing international audience for its content.

 Membership Subcommittee Chair David All mentioned the idea of developing an editorial calendar of individual Next Beverly Hills Committee member stories and that they are currently deciding who the lead will be for working with the City's Information Technology Department on potential updates to the Committee's webpage.

- Public Works Director Shana Epstein informed the Committee about the plan to explore recapturing storm water on Burton Way and making upgrades to the street and mentioned that there will be multiple upcoming community meetings for feedback on the City's Urban Forest Management Plan.
- Councilmember Wunderlich mentioned the notion of developing a process whereby the Next Beverly Hills Committee can take official stances on various items of discussion throughout the City.
- Councilmember Gold agreed and indicated that such a process would need to ensure a consensus is reached by the Committee membership before any official stances are adopted.
- Transportation Liaison Kory Klem gave an update that the City is currently studying potential options for a north portal entrance to the forthcoming subway station.
