## 2) Request for City Partnership for a BritWeek Car Rally and Show

- Presentation was provided to the liaisons by Nigel Lythgoe, BritWeek
- BritWeek proposal is a British car rally and show
- City partnership was requested for a waiver of fees/permits
- BritWeek would seek sponsors. The proposal also included:
  - Request for a N. Crescent Drive Street closure
  - High-end luxury vehicle motorcade to start at the Wallis along a predesignated route
    - Vehicles to be showcased along N. Crescent Drive and allow for the public to view cars
    - BritWeek would invite celebrity car owners to participate with their vehicles for the event
- Marketing plan for the event to include:
  - Use of local, British media and television through BritWeek
  - o City communications platforms to share event on social media
- City Council Liaison Direction:
  - Approved Britweek to seek sponsorship and further develop the program;
  - This item will be included in the next upcoming City Council meeting on November 6, as an information 'C' item.
  - BritWeek will return in early 2019 to provide a formal update on the program.

# 4) Updated Proposal for BHEF to Host Beverly Hills 5K-10K Walk/Run & Fitness Blast with All Seasons Fitness Media

- BHEF plans to raise \$30,000 (minimum) in donations.
- After BHEF exceeds the \$30,000 minimum, ASFM will receive 14% of sponsorship funding thereafter.
- City Council Direction:

  - Approved the use of City logo for promotion, medals and marketing,
  - Approved one street span banner for Beverly Hills 5K/10K along Wilshire/S. Santa Monica Blvd.
    - Banner design will be reviewed by City staff
  - BHEF will currently need to return on an annual basis for approval of this event.
